College Ready Math 2015-2016 Application

Thank you for your interest in College Ready Math. College Ready Math supports teachers in shifting their instructional practices by implementing the Math Design Collaborative (MDC) framework. The series is open to teams of math teachers (grades 6 through 12) and administrators interested in embedding formative assessment teaching practices using rigorous and real world math problems.

Applications for the 2015/2016 series must be [submitted online](#) and are due by June 26, 2015.

Prior to applying, please be sure to read through our [eBook](#) which outlines the program and covers important topics such as "who should attend?" and "what do participants need to know ahead of time?"

The summer overview session dates are July 29 – 30, 2015 in Columbus, Ohio. Two rounds of on-site job embedded sessions will be scheduled with your team to take place on your campus. Additionally a strategic planning, goals and full implementation session is planned for June 2016.

The cost to participate is based on your team size. The costs are outlined below. Additionally, participants will be expected to cover the cost of travel to/from the full group sessions.

On site Job embedded sessions

- Identify two or three options which would be a good fit for your district/school team to participate in the **Fall 2015** on site job embedded session?
 - Each option should be a 3 day range (Ex. Option 1: Sept 22-24, 2016).
 - Day 1 and day 3 require the team to participate in a 2 hour after school session.
 - On days 2 and 3, teachers are asked to implement an MDC lesson with support from a job embedded coach.
 - Example: Option 1 for the Fall 2015 could be *Sept 22-24, 2016*. This would mean that on Tuesday Sept 16th and Thursday Sept 18th the teachers and administrators would come together with their coach after school for two hours to look at student work, plan, and reflect on lesson implementation.
- Identify two or three options which would be a good fit for your district/school team to participate in the **Winter/Spring 2016** on site job embedded session?
 - Each option should be a 3 day range
 - Day 1 and day 3 require the team to participate in a 2 hour after school session.
 - On days 2 and 3, teachers are asked to implement an MDC lesson with support from a job embedded coach.
 - Example: Option 1 for the Winter 2016 could be *Feb 16-18, 2016*. This would mean that on Tuesday Feb 16th and Thursday Feb 18th the teachers and administrators would come together with their coach after school for two hours to look at student work, plan, and reflect on lesson implementation.

Individual*	<p>This selection is reserved for schools which have already had a team participate and which are interested in having an additional teacher trained.</p> <p>Please note, if you select "Individual" this does not include job embedded support. It is therefore critical for the school to have a plan in place for the individual to receive support from their trained colleagues. This option includes the two (2) day overview session and the one (1) day goals and implementation session.</p> <p>* Provision of the training is dependent upon receipt of a minimum number of interested registrants.</p>	\$675.00
