Please be sure you are prepared to complete the entire application including uploading documents. You will not be able to leave the application and come back to finish later.

Thank you for your interest in the Innovative Leader Institute (ILI). Dates for the 2016-2017 ILI are: May 15 (evening) - May 17 (late afternoon), October 12, 2017, February 1, 2018, and April 26, 2018. The May session will be in Columbus. Remaining locations are still to be determined.

The ILI is open to two person teams of school leaders interested in or currently leading innovative schools or programs. The team must include a principal or assistant principal plus an additional building-level leader. Each applicant must complete the on-line application separately including uploading all required documents.

Fees for the ILI are \$1,000 per person. Participants also will be expected to cover the cost of travel to/from the ILI sites. Application decisions and dates and locations will be delivered by April 17, 2017.
