Example 2: I plan to purchase 10 backpacks and a variety of materials like stickers, blocks, balloons, and duct tape to stock the STEM Backpacks.

Example 3: I plan to purchase a variety of STEM items for our library STEM corner such as K'NEX, LEGO, Magna-Tiles, and Brackitz.

Note: Budgets must outline all the funding requested. For example: If you request \$2,500 in funding but only outline \$2,200 on the budget, we are unable to process this application, and it will be disqualified.

Item costs may be estimated when necessary. Applications that fail to use the proper template or upload a blank document will be disqualified.

Name your Excel file as follows: Budget ProjectTitle (e.g., Budget Seguatchie River Water Study).

What is the organization name listed in Line 1 of the W9? This must match IRS records for the EIN number. Checks are only made out to public school districts (not the school itself) unless special arrangements have been made.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. Should I be awarded a grant, I agree to fully expend the grant funds as outlined in the submitted proposal by June 1, 2026. I understand that any purchases not outlined in the proposal must be approved by Battelle prior to purchasing.
- 2. Should I be awarded a grant, I agree that everything purchased with the grant funds is to become property of the school and must stay with the school even if the individual who requested the grant departs.
- 3. Should I be awarded a grant, I agree to submit a Student Impact Report on or before June 30, 2026. I understand that this report must include how the funds were used, a brief description of the project's implementation and outcomes, the number of educators and students served, and at least one photograph.
- 4. Should I be awarded a grant, I give the Ohio STEM Learning Network and Battelle permission to use all information in the submitted proposal as well as photographs, logos, published/printed information, and any other information related to this grant and how the funds were spent in press releases, on their website, and/or in publications both in print and online.
- 5. I understand that awards must be made to an organization or fiscal agent that is tax-exempt under Internal Revenue Service code 501(c)(3) or a governmental entity. Awards will not be made to individuals. All grant award checks will be issued and mailed directly to the respective **School District Office**. In cases where multiple awards are granted within a district, a letter detailing the allocation of individual grant amounts will accompany the disbursement.
